Cardiac Catheterization Labs and Interventional Radiology Expansion Update

With the support of generous **donors like you**, Surrey Memorial Hospital (SMH) is opening two brand new Cardiac Catheterization Labs (Cath Labs) – a specialized area where cardiac specialists perform minimally invasive tests and advanced life-saving cardiac procedures, **allowing residents south of the Fraser to be treated in their own community**.

Equipped with state-of-the-art imaging technology, the labs will be used to view arteries and check blood flow to-and-from the heart. They will be equipped with an image intensifier or flat panel detector, viewing monitors, an injector pump, angioplasty balloons, an X-ray image intensifier for fluoroscopic imaging, and a single X-ray generator source.

In 2023, we began with the ambitious goal of raising \$10 million. We have \$1 million left to raise to reach our goal by March 2025!

Nowhere in BC will the burden of heart disease be felt more acutely than in the Fraser Health region.

> Surrey is projected to become BC's largest city by 2029.

Surrey's growing aging population **will be the largest amongst all health authorities in the province**.

Our region is expected to have one of the largest population of South Asian residents in North America, studies show people of South Asian descent have **four times the risk of heart disease**.

Given these factors, it is essential that SMH be able to provide quicker access to urgent cardiac interventions and deliver life-saving cardiac treatments right here, close to home.
